

ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES AND GRADE LEVELS

Students will be enrolled in grades and classes in which they can be expected to master established district learning and instructional objectives. All students who are included under the compulsory attendance law must be enrolled and required to attend all classes prescribed by the state and the district, unless exempt by the school authorities.

Students transferring into the school district will be placed in the grade level and class that best meets the student's needs. The appropriate placement will occur after consultation between the building administrator and the student's parents/guardians and review of prior educational records.

A student will be placed in a grade level classroom after careful consideration by school personnel with parental/guardian input. The decision for class placement will be made after reviewing a student's previous performance regarding academic strengths and weaknesses, social, emotional, and physical well-being.

The decision of the building administrator regarding student placement may be appealed to the superintendent and then to the school board.
