

**Suspension of Pupils**

Annually, the Superintendent shall designate, in writing, authorization for administrators to suspend pupils from school for a period not to exceed ten (10) school days for gross misconduct, for neglect or for refusal to conform to the reasonable rules of the school.

The School Board authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to continue the suspension of a pupil for a period in excess of ten (10) school days. Pursuant to the Due Process Policy, the student, parent(s) and or guardian will be advised of their opportunity for a hearing. The student shall have an opportunity for a hearing before the Superintendent prior to the imposition of the additional suspension.
