

IDENTIFICATION OF NON-ENGLISH LANGUAGE BACKGROUND STUDENTS

In accordance with the school board’s policy of non-discrimination and in light of the fact that New Hampshire is an English only state, the school board has established a program for Non-English language background students.

Services must be provided to students who have a primary language other than English, have or may have difficulty performing ordinary class work in English, or cannot learn or achieve equally with their peers whose dominant language is English.
