

SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

As elected officials, school board members are bound to uphold the applicable provisions of State law. Grounds for removal from office include violation of RSA 32:12, relating to the expenditures of district monies, and RSA 42:1-a, breaching confidentiality standards.

A school board member shall not be removed from office by either the voters or the school board itself, except as provided in RSA 32:12 and RSA 42:1-a.
