

ADMINISTRATION IN POLICY ABSENCE

In the absence of established school board policy or school board guidelines, the superintendent of schools will have the power to act. The superintendent shall assume responsibility for whatever decision or action is taken. The superintendent shall promptly inform the board chair of decision or action taken which may be subject to review by action of the school board at a regular or special meeting.

In the absence of a policy, school district administrator(s) and/or building administrator(s) shall gain the approval of the superintendent before taking any action.
