

**WALKERS AND RIDERS**

All students living on streets that are not located on the bus routes will be required to walk to the nearest bus stop. Students will be picked up and discharged only at authorized bus stops. All students are expected to be at the bus stop before the bus is scheduled to arrive.

A student must ride only the bus to which he/she is assigned. Exceptions will be granted in cases where the student brings a written notification from the parent or guardian. The school personnel will only accept verbal notifications for changes of buses from a parent or guardian. The building administrator, and or designee, will inform the bus driver accordingly

Students may not ride beyond their bus stop or get off at any bus stop other than the bus stop assigned, except as previously noted. Approval for a student to ride a non-assigned bus will be granted only by the building administrator and only if space is available on the bus. Students who are not authorized to ride the bus may not ride the bus at any time.
