

TRANSPORTATION OF KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS

Kindergarten students will be released from school buses at their home or other formally agreed upon destination only when a parent /guardian or other authorized adult is present to receive them. Bus drivers must be able to clearly see the receiving adult or students will not be discharged but returned to the school where parents will be contacted by phone. Any changes in student destination must be arranged in writing through the school personnel.

Furthermore the following procedures are in place to ensure the safety of kindergarten students.

- Kindergarten students must sit in the first three rows of the bus.
- Lists by bus of kindergarten students riding p.m. routes including addresses will be supplied by the school to the school district bus company. The bus company will then ensure that all drivers are aware of kindergarten students riding their bus and will be familiar with them to ensure that all policies are enforced.
- Kindergarten bus rosters will be updated and supplied to the bus company as needed.
