

**STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS**

The school board recognizes the student teacher program as an important aspect of a future teacher's education. Therefore, the school board will cooperate with institutions of a higher education in training student teachers.

All persons involved in this program must recognize that the first and primary responsibility of the school district is to the students within its schools. If at any time a student teacher becomes unacceptable, the school district reserves the right to refuse that student teacher further teaching experience within the school district.

Student teachers who work in the school district shall be accepted only after approval of the superintendent and the principal of the building in which the person is to teach.

Student teachers, when employed as a substitute for the classroom teacher, are restricted to no more than three non-consecutive days.

Student teachers shall be subject to a Criminal History Records Check prior to working in the school district. The cost of the Criminal History Records Check is to be paid by the school district.
